SOUTH DAKOTA HONOR CHOIR RULES AND REGULATIONS

These rules and regulations are for your benefit and protection. Please familiarize yourself with them and abide by them. South Dakota High School Association Activity Rules will be enforced. In the event that guidelines of conduct are abused, the camp director and at least one other member of the executive board will meet with the involved students and may make the decision to dismiss the student from the concert and/or Honor Choir. Parents and directors will be notified and the student will be sent home.

- 1. Attendance at all rehearsals is mandatory.
- 2. All students must live on campus. Permission to leave campus for emergency purposes can only be granted by the Honor Choir Executive Director, Stacy Gross.
- 3. Honor Choir members will not be allowed to drive during the camp. For this reason, <u>students are highly discouraged from bringing cars to camp.</u> Any necessary transportation will be provided and students must use campus-provided transportation only. If students must drive to camp, keys must be turned in to the Camp Dean on Sunday at check-in. They will be returned after the final concert.
- 4. Dormitory regulations:
 - a. Curfew must be in dorms by 10:00 p.m.; in rooms at 10:30 p.m.; lights out at 11:00 p.m. This will be strictly enforced, as these are busy days and you will need your rest to ensure good vocal health.
 - b. Cell phone use will be allowed for emergencies only!
 - c. Visitors (other than Honor Choir members) are at no time allowed in dorm rooms or on campus. Parents/guardians will be allowed in the dorms to help their Honor Choir member move in on the first day of camp and/or move out on the last day of camp and in the event of an emergency.
 - d. No men on women's dorm floors or rooms and vice-versa.
 - e. No intoxicants, illegal drugs, or tobacco products shall be possessed, consumed, or used on campus property.
 - f. Any tampering or misuse of fire equipment or alarms is strictly forbidden.
 - g. Any destruction, removal of or damage to college property will be billed to the parent(s) of the student(s) responsible.
 - h. Rooms should be kept locked at all times. You are responsible for any lost or stolen items. There will be a fee assessed for any dorm key that is lost or not turned in at check-out time.
 - i. Possession or use of firecrackers or other materials, which endanger the welfare of others, will be sufficient cause for dismissal from the dorm and Honor Choir.
 - j. Any actions that endanger the individual, the campus community, or the welfare of other summer participants will be cause for dismissal.
